



Day 4 - (Monday) ROME - PISA - FLORENCE

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Departure to Pisa. Upon arrival we will enjoy a regular city sightseeing tour. Pisa is a quiet city and very pleasant, close to the sea, that has preserved various evidences of her past greatness. We visit the famous Piazza dei Miracoli (Field of Miracles), and will admire its Duomo, the Leaning Tower and the Baptistery. We visit the Cathedral. In the afternoon we will continue to Florence known worldwide as the "Cradle of the Renaissance". Overnight.

Day 5 - (Tuesday) FLORENCE / CHIANTI REGION / FLORENCE

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Today we leave for an unforgettable excursion day in the CHIANTI region, famous throughout the world for its wines and its enchanting landscape. We will travel through the most amazing areas of Tuscany, renowned around the world for its delicious wine and for the incomparable beauty of its countryside, where woods, vineyards and olive groves alternate, studded with rural estates, mansions and castles of rare beauty. We will visit an imposing medieval Castle with its historic winery, its beautiful garden and the Patio: here we will enjoy a tasting of selected fine wines accompanied by local products. In the afternoon we return to Florence accommodation. Overnight.

Day 6 - (Wednesday) FLORENCE / MONTERIG-GIONI / SAN GIMIGNANO / SIENA

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Our journey will start with an excursion through the beautiful hills of the Chianti countryside, offering an impressive vineyard setting and olive groves. Along the way, from the wide panoramic windows of our coach, we will discover the medieval village of Monteriggioni, surrounded by its famous walls that have remained intact until today. Upon arrival in Siena, we enjoy a walking guided tour of the old town starting from the famous Basilica of San Domenico (visit inside), a jewel of Renaissance art built in the thirteenth century, and preserving an important relic of Santa Caterina da Siena. The guided tour will continue with a visit to the Museum and the oratory of a "Contrada" where we will discover the authentic atmosphere of the city. The "Contradas" (the neighborhoods into which the city is divided) are the real core of local social life, where the inhabitants of each district compete with each other to prepare the famous horse race known as the Palio. Each contrada is not simply a neighborhood: it can be compared to a small state with its

own legacy of traditions, memories and feelings, in addition to its flag and anthem. After free lunch we head to San Gimignano, a small walled town located on a hill, which has remained intact throughout the centuries and is famous for its tall towers, frescoes and other valuable works of art. We will visit a small and fascinating museum housed in a medieval palace. At the end of our visit, we enjoy a tasting of the aromatic and delicious Sienese artisan pastries of medieval tradition (ricciarelli and panforte) together with the famous local wines, among which the Vernaccia di San Gimignano stands out. We return to Florence. Overnight.

Day 7 - (Thursday) FLORENCIA - PIENZA -MONTEPULCIANO (Vino Nobile) - ORVIETO - ROME

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. We will start our excursion to the Val D'Orcia, a World Heritage Site for the Unesco since 2004, where we will find two little gems of Italy, the cities of Pienza and Montepulciano. Pienza is considered the "touchstone of Renaissance urbanism". It is considered the Renaissance utopia incarnation of an ideal city, which, from an architectural point of view, is characterized by a rational organization of the open spaces and perspectives of squares and palaces, for this reason, in 1996 the Unesco declared the historic center of the city as Humanity's Heritage. The city is also renowned for its pecorino cheese that we can taste and buy in local stores during our free time, when we will also have the opportunity to enjoy this charming little town and the captivating landscapes of its surroundings. Later we will continue our tour to Montepulciano, birth town of the famous Italian poet Angelo Poliziano. Here we will admire its architectural treasures, its beautiful Renaissance buildings and impressive churches. Another feature of this city is its old wine tradition, the Nobile of Montepulciano, one of the most famous Tuscan wines. We will enjoy a fantastic wine tasting in one of the most popular wineries in the region. We then continue to Orvieto, a small town of Etruscan origin, known for its beautiful 14th century cathedral considered one of the masterpieces of Italian Gothic architecture. After visit we continue on to Rome and our hotel. Overnight.

Day 8 - (Friday) ROMA

Breakfast. Free time until your transfer to the local airport, in time for your flight back.

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Departure to Pisa. Upon arrival we will enjoy a regular city sightseeing tour. Pisa is a quiet city and very pleasant, close to the sea, that has preserved various evidences of her past greatness. We visit the famous Piazza dei Miracoli (Field of Miracles), and will admire its Duomo, the Leaning Tower and the Baptistery. We visit the Cathedral. In the afternoon we will continue to La Spezia. Overnight.

Day 5 - (Tuesday) LA SPEZIA - CINQUE TERRE - SIENA (225 kms)

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Departure on a full day excursion at famous "Cinque Terre". Five fascinating towns of vivid colors located on cliffs above the sea. Hundreds of hiking trails run through this unspoiled landscape, framed by nature and wonderful views. We will enjoy Castles, walls and other ancient buildings, as well as many small beaches, some of them isolated and unspoiled. In the afternoon we will continue towards Siena. Overnight.

Day 6 - (Wednesday) SIENA - MONTALCINO - SAN GIMIGNANO - SIENA (175 kms)

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. City sightseeing tour of the city including Piazza del Campo, site of the famous Palio race, and the Cathedral that we will visit inside. Free time for lunch. Next, we will go to Montalcino where we will visit a small and typical winery, take a little walk through the ancient vineyards, visit the barrel room and taste the excellent wines, accompanied by local products. After the winery, we will continue to San Gimignano, a small walled town located on a hill that has remained intact throughout the centuries, famous for its tall towers, frescoes and other valuable works of art. Brief visit through the old town, where we will have free time to discover the tiny streets and nice squares in the city center. Return to Siena at the end of visit. Overnight.

Day 7 - (Thursday) SIENA - PIENZA - MONTE-PULCIANO - ROME (270 kms)

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Today we will enjoy an excursion to the Val D'Orcia, visiting two little gems of Italy, the cities of Pienza and Montepulciano, We can consider them the perfect introduction to this fascinating natural area, one of the most beautiful in Italy, where you will enjoy these charming little cities and the captivating landscapes of their surroundings. Pienza is considered the "touchstone of Renaissance urbanism" and is also renowned for its pecorino cheese that we can taste and buy in local stores during our free time. Later we will continue our tour to Montepulciano and will admire its architectural treasures, its beautiful Renaissance buildings and impressive churches. Another feature of this city is its old wine tradition, the Nobile of Montepulciano, one of the most famous Tuscan wines. We will enjoy a fantastic wine tasting in one of the most popular wineries in the region. We then continue to Rome. Overnight.

Day 1 - ROME - NAPLES - POMPEII - SORRENTO (277 kms)

Leaving Rome and heading south, we take the so-called Highway of the Sun, crossing the Roman countryside and passing through the area known as Castelli Romani. Halfway we will sight the Abbey of Montecassino, also known for its famous battle and total destruction during World War II. Once we arrive in Naples, we descend towards the port of Mergellina and following the coast road we reach the old fishermen's neighborhood of Santa Lucia. We will view the impressive Castel dell'Ovo (photo stop). Then we will leave the city and drive through the fertile valley of Mount Vesuvius and the cities of Ercolano, Torre del Greco and Torre Annunziata before we finally reach Pompeii. We stop for lunch. Thereafter, we will visit the excavations on a walking tour with a local guide leading us in an archaeological journey through this ancient city. In approximately 2 hours you will see part of the discoveries that have taken place in more than 1,700 years, basically since Pompeii was covered in ash during the eruption of Vesuvius in 79 AD. Through the remains and ruins of this ancient city we can imagine the daily life in the Imperial Era and above all the panic that people felt in those last minutes, before the city was so disastrously buried. We will then visit a coral and cameos factory where we have the opportunity to admire and buy items of this ancient craft dating from the Greek times. Continue by bus along one of the scenic and most beautiful roads in Italy known as the "Sorrento's Coast". We arrive our hotel in the afternoon, dinner and accommodation.

Day 2 - SORRENTO - CAPRI - SORRENTO

After breakfast we reach the port of Sorrento to take the hydrofoil to Island of Capri. After approximately 20 minutes of navigation we arrive at the port of Marina Grande. We then take local motor boats and then rowboats

to visit the Blue Grotto (weather permitting), followed by a walking tour of Capri and a scenic drive to Anacapri by minibus. Lunch is included. We then have some free time before we take our hydrofoil back to Sorrento. Dinner and overnight.

Day 3 - SORRENTO

Breakfast at the hotel. Free day in Sorrento to explore the city or take an excursion on the Amalfi Coast. Overnight.

Day 4 - SORRENTO - ROME (265 kms)

After breakfast, another day at our leisure to enjoy the climate and the beauty of this seaside town. In the afternoon board our bus and transfer back to Rome. The approximate time of arrival will be at 8:00/8:30 pm. Overnight.

Day 5 - ROME


Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the airport on time for our departure flight.

USEFUL INFORMATION: we recommend wearing comfortable dress and shoes, and during summertime, to wear sunglasses and a hat or cap to avoid the risk of sunstroke, as well as giving full attention to your guide's advice and recommendations. From April 1 to October 31 your guide will provide earphones to visit the excavations of Pompeii. NOTE: the porterage service is not included in the package price. The approximate cost of this service is € 20.00, to be paid directly on site. For logistical reasons, the name of the hotel in Sorrento will be informed the same day of arrival.

Day 1º ROME

Arrival in Rome. Transfer to the hotel by private car. Balance of the day at leisure. Overnight.

Day 2º ROME

Breakfast. In the morning visit of the Eternal city, you will live and feel this beautiful city through its picturesque little streets, discovering some of the most famous places of the world like the Pantheon, with its impressive dome and its "Oculus" (opening on the top of the dome), Piazza Navona, Fontana di Trevi and the Spanish Steps. Stop in the Piazza Colonna, where you will see the column of Emperor Marco Aurelio, considered by the Romans the real city center. We end with a visit to the Fountain of the Four Rivers, sculpted by Bernini, rising majestically



in the center of Piazza Navona. The afternoon will be free to enjoy the city or to do some shopping, try a typical meal or simply walk through its streets and beautiful bridges. Overnight.

Day 3° ROME - FLORENCE (train)

Breakfast. Departure by train to Florence the Renaissance city. Enjoy the journey admiring the beautiful landscapes of Tuscany. Arrive in Florence. The balance of the day will be free to explore the city and enjoy its gastronomy. Overnight.

Day 4° FLORENCE - VENICE (train)

Breakfast. In the morning panoramic sightseeing tour to learn the history and the monuments of Florence. We visit San Lorenzo neighborhood and learn the story of the powerful Medici family who ruled the city during the Renaissance era. Arrival in Rome. Transfer to the hotel. Balance of the day at leisure. Overnight.

Day 2° (Monday) ROME - PIETRELCINA - SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO (430 kms)

After breakfast we depart to San Giovanni Rotondo, located in the charming region of Puglia, whose coastal strip stretches with sand from Oso Torre to Porto Cesario and rocks in Otranto and Santa Maria di Leuca. We will make a stop in the beautiful village of Pietrelcina located in Campania, in the province of Benevento. Padre Pio was sent to the convent of San Giovanni Rotondo on September 4th, 1916. He was the first priest to have printed on his body the marks of the crucifixion (The Stigmata). He spent his life in San Giovanni Rotondo in the realization of two initiatives following two directions: the vertical one, towards God, with the establishment of the "Groups of Prayer". and the horizontal one, towards the brothers, with the construction of a modern hospital, the "House of Relief from Suffering." We visit the old monastery with the room where Padre Pio lived with his clothes and articles of daily use, the old Church of "Santa Maria delle Grazie" where he celebrated masses everyday. The grave is in the new church, visited by millions of pilgrims. In the afternoon we visit Monte Sant'Angelo and the mystic Sanctuary dedicated to St. Michael the Archangel. His story is related to the appearance of the Saint in the Grotto, on May 8th, 490 and the following apparitions (492 and 493) that made this place a devotional and pilgrimage site. We visit its beautiful Basilica, the Via Franciscana also called Via Sacra de los Longabardos, the bell tower, as well as other pilgrim's points of interest. Return to San Giovanni Rotonto. Overnight.

Day 4º (Wednesday) SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO

- LANCIANO - LORETO - ASSISI (450 kms)

Breakfast. Departure to Lanciano and visit to the Shrine of the Eucharistic Miracle. Lanciano is a small medieval town, inside the Church of St. Francis we can still see the first and greatest Eucharistic miracle occurred more than 12 centuries ago. After visit we continue towards Loreto, to visit the Santa Casa, located in the Great Basilica, that is the same house in Nazareth that Archangel Gabriel visited at the Annunciation to the Blessed Virgin Mary and where the "Word became Flesh and dwelt among us". This sanctuary has become one of the greatest Marian pilgrimage sites. We then continue to Assisi, the city of St Francis. Passing through the medieval Porta Nova we walk to the Church Santa Clara, then continue to the New Church and the Piazza del Comune with the two municipalities buildings and the Temple of Minerva. We continue with a visit to the Basilica of Saint Francis, rebuilt after the earthquake of 1997 that damaged part of the upper basilica as well as the frescoes. In a small crypt, under the main altar, are the remains of the Saint. Overnight.

Day 5° (Thursday) ASSISI - CASCIA - ROME (250 kms)

Breakfast. Departure for Cascia and its Sanctuary dedicated to St. Rita. Here the saint lived for more than forty years her experience of monastic life, until her death. The complex, built in the 13th century, was originally dedicated to St. Mary Magdalene, then in the 18th century it was enlarged to become the home of the community of the Augustinian Sisters. In the monastery you can see some sites related to the life of Santa Rita, the patio with a well, the old choir that preserves the frescoes of the 16th century and paintings from the 17th and 18th centuries, the oratory where Santa Rita received the stigmata, the cells, the bedroom of the saint and containing objects that belonged to her, like her wedding ring, and various sarcophagi. The rose garden, recreated to remember the miracle of the rose and figs. Continue to Rome the Eternal city. Overnight.

Day 6° (Friday) ROME

Breakfast. At the established time, transfer to the local airport to board our flight back.

End of services.



GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. LEGAL REGULATION AND ACCEPTANCE OF THE CONDITIONS

These General Terms and Conditions are subject to the regulation of the Book IV of the Royal Legislative Decree 1/2007, dated November 16, 2007, and other rules in force. Once signed by the contracting parties, these General Conditions will be incorporated into all tourist package contracts concerning the tours and offers contained in this brochure, which oblige the parties to the particular conditions agreed in it as well as the provision of the services indicated in the travel documentation provided simultaneously with the signing of the contract. The contracting parties expressly submit to the jurisdiction and competence of the Spanish Courts with authority in the place where the obligation is performed, waiving their own jurisdiction.

2. ORGANIZATION

The tours mentioned in this brochure has been arranged by EUROPEANDO S.L. CIF B-87173696. CICMA license title n° 3207.

3. PRICE

3.1. The price of the combined tours include

- a. Transportation according to itinerary.
- b. The hotels mentioned in the brochure are merely for information and the accommodation and / or meals (if included) in the hotels or in other similar establishments can be changed without notice with structures of equal value and category- The included breakfasts will be "continental type" unless otherwise indicated.
- c. Hotel taxes and indirect taxes (v.a.t.; i.g.i.c.) when they are applicable.
- d. Technical assistance during the tours, when this service is specifically included.
- All other services and supplements specifically mentioned in the itineraries and all that is further specified in the contract.

The expected waiting time at the airport for arrival transfers is set at a maximum of 90 minutes from the flight's arrival. Rates and descriptions in this brochure are valid except for typographical errors.

3.2. Price adjustements

The price of each package tour has been calculated on the basis of the current exchange rates, transport charges, fuel costs and taxes applicable on the date of issue of this brochure or any subsequent publications, if any, made public in printed form.

Any change in the price of the items indicated above may result in the revision of the final price of the tours, both increasing and decreasing, strictly in the price changes to which they refer.

3.3. Exclusions

a. Package Tour's rates do not include Visas, airport taxes, and / or entry and exit taxes, vaccination certificates, "extras" such as coffees, wines, spirits, mineral waters, special diets, washing and ironing of clothes, optional hotel services, and in general any services or benefits not expressly mentioned in the brochure, schedule or documentation of the journey.

4. PAYMENT METHOD. REGISTRATIONS AND REFUNDS

The Agency will require at the moment of registration a deposit of 40% of the total amount of the contracted tour price and will issue a receipt: nothing will be booked until the above deposit is paid. The remaining 60% must be paid at least seven days before the departure date, otherwise the tour will be considered as canceled, and the conditions set out in the cancellation terms shall apply. All refunds made for any reason, will always be formalized through the Travel Agency where the registration was made, no refund is made for services not used voluntarily by the costumer.

5. CANCELLATIONS

At any time the user or customer may withdraw from the services requested or contracted, being entitled to a refund of the amounts paid both the total price or the deposit paid. In any case the customer shall compensate the Agency for the following:

- a. Operational costs plus cancellation costs, if any.
- b. A penalty fee consisting of 15% of the total trip, if the withdrawal occurs more than ten and less than fifteen days before the departure; 50% from day 3 to 10 before departure and 75% within the 48 hours before departure.

In case of no-show at the departure, the penalty fee will be 100% of the total amount of the trip, paying, where appropriate, the outstanding amounts, unless otherwise agreed by the parties. In the event that any of the contracted and canceled services were subject to special economic conditions of contracting, such as airfare, ships, special rates, etc., the cancellation costs for withdrawal will be established in accordance with the conditions agreed by both parties. A minimum of fifteen passengers is required to carry out the tours. In case this quota has not been obtained, the trip will be automatically canceled, which will be notified in writing to the consumer, with a minimum of twenty days before the scheduled departure date, and in this case they will not be entitled to any compensation. The circuit may leave without an accompanying guide, with an expert driver who knows the routes.

6. ALTERATIONS

The Agency undertakes to provide its customers with the totality of the services agreed and contained in the package offered which originated the contract, with the stipulated conditions and characteristics. In the event that before departure the organizer is forced to significantly modify any essential item of the contract, it must immediately inform the consumer. In this case and unless the parties agree otherwise, the customer may choose between terminating the contract without any penalty, or accepting the modification of the contract in which the variations introduced and their impact on the price are specified. The costumer must communicate the decision adopted to the retailer or, when appropriate, to the organizer, within three days after being notified. In the event that the consumer does not notify his decision in the indicated terms, it will be understood that he opts for the termination of the contract without any penalty.

In the event of contractual liability of the Agency provided for in this paragraph, the corresponding compensation shall be those regulated in Article 159,1 of Book IV of RD 1/2007 of 16/11/2007. In the event of withdrawal or cancellation by the Agency, the Organizer and the Retailer will be responsible for refunding the customer the compensation provided in Book IV of RD 1/2007 of 11/16/2007, in the terms and conditions fixed therein as follows:

 a. 5% of the total package price, if the withdrawal occurs between two months and fifteen days prior the tour departure date;

- b. 10%, if it occurs between the previous fifteen and three days prior the tour departure date;
- c. c. 25%, if it occurs in the previous 48 hours prior the tour departure date.

In the event that, after the departure of the trip, the Organizer does not supply or also verify that it cannot supply an important part of the services provided for in the contract, it will adopt the appropriate solutions for the continuation of the organized tour without any additional price for the customer, and, if necessary, will pay the latter the amount of the difference between the benefits exprected and those provided. If the costumer continues the trip with the solutions given by the Organizer, it will be considered that they tacitly accept said proposals. If the solutions adopted by the Organizer are unfeasible, or the consumer does not accept them for reasonable reasons, the Organizer must provide the Customer, without any supplement, a means of transport equivalent to that used on the trip to return to the place of departure or to any other place that both have agreed, without prejudice to the compensation that may be appropriate.

7. RESPONSIBILITY

The Organizers and Retailers of package tours will respond to the Customer, depending on the obligations that correspond to them by their respective area of management of the package trip, for the correct fulfillment of the obligations deriving from the contract, regardless of whether they are to be carried out by themselves or by other service providers, and without prejudice to the right of Organisers and Retailers to take action against such service providers.

The organizers and retailers of package tours will also be liable for the damages suffered by the ustomer as a result of the failure or incorrect execution of the contract. Said responsibility will cease when any of the following circumstances occurs:

- a. That the defects observed in the execution of the contract are caused by the Customer;
- That said defects are attributable to a third party unrelated to the provision of the services provided for in the contract and are unpredictable or insurmountable;
- c. That the aforementioned defects are due to reasons of force majeure, meaning that such those circumstances beyond the control of the person invoking them, abnormal and unforeseeable, the consequences of which could not have been avoided despite having acted with due dilicence:
- d. That the defects are due to an event that the Retailer or, where appropriate, the Organizer, despite having put all the necessary diligence, could not foresee or overcome.

When the customer verifies the non-execution or defective execution of the contracted services "in situ", he must immediately notify the provider of the same, and within 48 business hours to the Organizing Agency, in order to be able to solve it immediately, since, outside of that period, it would be almost impossible for it to verify the veracity of the allegations. In the event that the consumer considers that the solutions arbitrated by the Organizing Agency have not been satisfactory, he may submit a claim within a period of one month from the date of return from the trip with the aforementioned Organizing Agency, which will be presented through of the Retail Agency that sold the trip, and in which it will be credited to have made manifest the presumed breach in the 48 hours following its occurrence. However, the filing of any claim derived from the package travel contract does not exempt the payment of the trip in any case. In the case of damage other than personal injury, compensation may never exceed the total price of the trip initially contracted. In no case is the Agency responsible for accommodation, maintenance, transportation and other expenses that arise as a result of delays in departures or returns of means of transport due to weather, technical, strikes or other force majeure. When the trip is made in coaches of its own or rented by the Organizing Agency, in the event of an accident, regardless of the country where it occurs, the consumer expressly submits to the legislation on road accidents of the nation in which it is registered the vehicle. The main contractor, declares to have the powers to contract on behalf of the remaining beneficiaries of the trip integrated in the same reservation locator, and also declares to know and accept everything outlined in the clauses of this contract, as well as expressly declares to have knowledge of the risks inherent to the trip that is the object of this contract.

8. PASSPORTS. VISAS AND DOCUMENTATION

The client receives a general information about the conditions that apply to them in terms of passports and visas, and the health formalities necessary for the trip and stay. All users, without exception (children included), must carry their corresponding personal and family documentation, be it their passport or ID, according to the laws of the country or countries they are visiting. It will be their duty obtaining visas, passports, vaccination certificates, etc., when required. If the granting of visas is rejected by any Authority, for particular reasons of the user, or their entry into a country is denied due to lack of the necessary requirements or due to defects in the required documentation, or by not being the carrier of the same, the Organizing Agency will not be responsible in any case, being on behalf of the consumer all the expenses that for these reasons originate.

9. BAGGAGE

The baggage and other personal effects of the customer are not the subject of the tourist package contract, it being understood that in terms of land transport and to all effects, the user keeps them with him regardless of where they are placed in the part of the vehicle in which is traveling and transported at the user's own risk, without the Organizing Agency being held responsible for loss, theft or damage that it may suffer during the trip for any reason, including the management of hotel / airport transfers or vice versa, when they exist. Users are recommended to be present in all baggage loading and unloading operations. Due to the limited capacity of the buses, a maximum of one suitcase (max. 20 kg) and one bag per person will be allowed.

10. INSURANCE

These Package tours are covered by accident insurance. Consumers receive information on the coverage, as well as the possibility of contracting an insurance that covers the cancellation costs by the consumer, or an assistance contract that covers the costs of transfer to the place the ground services begin, in case of accident, illness or death.

11. VALIDITY

However, changes in that information shall be valid, both in the characteristics of the services covered and in the prices thereof, if communicated to the Customer before the conclusion of the contract or where modifications have been agreed between the parties.

Note: Sections no.3.3, 3.4.2, 3.4.3, 3.4.4, 7, 8, 10, and 12 of these general conditions will be available to customers in accordance with the provisions of Book IV of the Royal Decree of 1/2007 of 11/16/2007.
