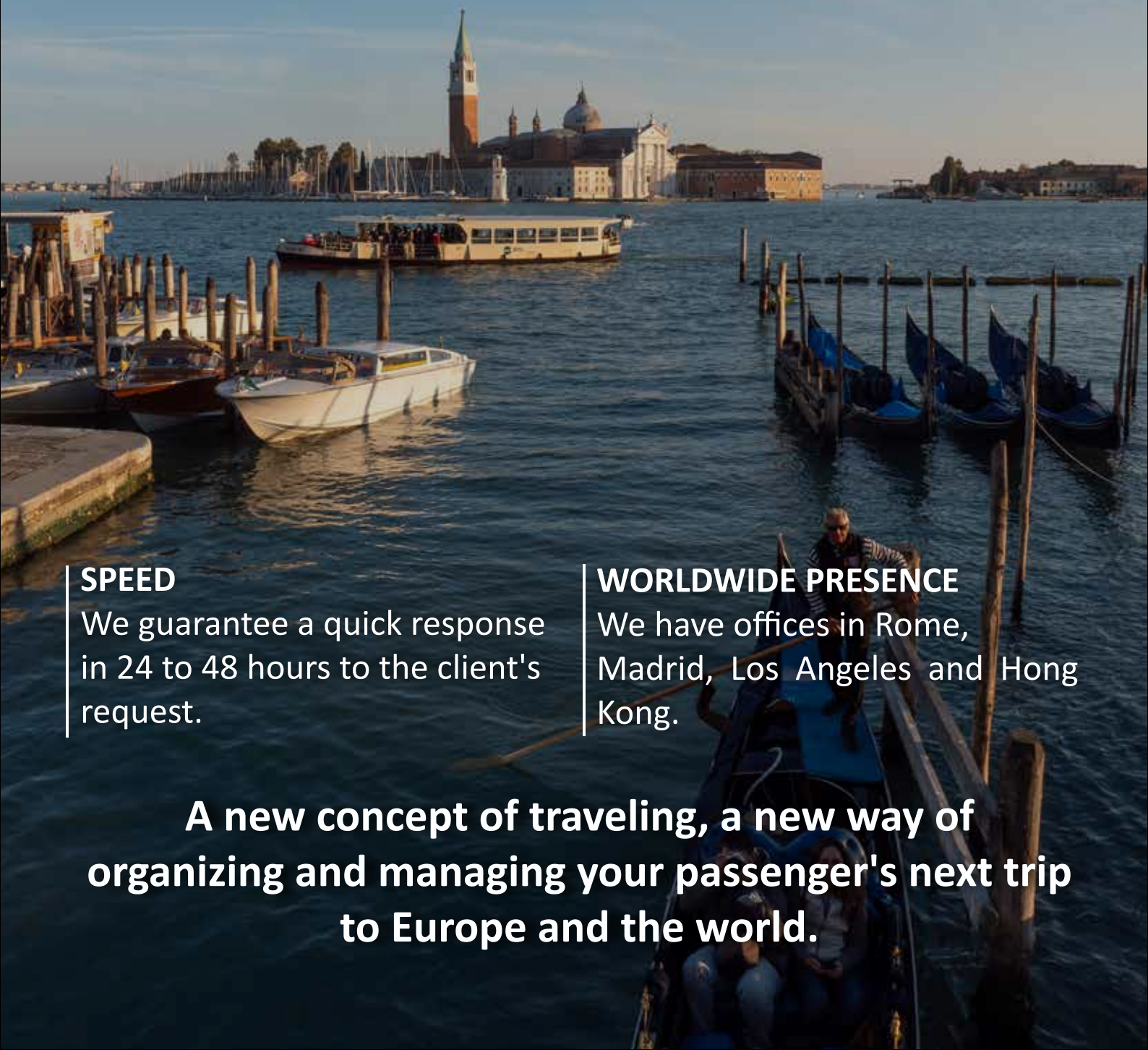

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE TRANSFER

As reported in each programs in this catalog, transfers from the airport or station to the hotel at the beginning and also from the hotel to the airport or station at the end of the circuit are included.

In those cases in which it is expressly mentioned that the arrival or departure transfer was not included in the price of the tour, the possibility of requesting the service will always be offered by means of a small supplement in the price.

In those cases in which additional nights are requested, be they pre or post tour, the departure or arrival transfer will also be included without additional charge in most of the programs, provided that the additional nights have been reserved and included in your program of travel.

In arrival transfers, a waiting time of one hour is established from the arrival of the flight or train to meet the passengers. If the arrival or departure from Europe is done through an airport other than the usual ones and planned in the circuits, it will be necessary to pay a supplement for transfer, because the airport is at a distance from the city greater than expected.

Such a circumstance occurs for example at Gatwick or Luton airport in London, Ciampino in Rome, or Treviso in Venice.



TRANSPORTATION BY COACH

Thinking of your comfort, we put at your disposal a modern fleet of luxury coaches with air conditioning, panoramic windows, reclining seats, equipped with the latest technology in free Wi-Fi for you, and driven by expert drivers, very knowledgeable about the routes, that go through our programs complying at all times with the regulations of the European Union.

The trunk of the bus has enough space to transport one suitcase per person, and for this reason the transport of one suitcase per passenger is guaranteed.

If it were the case that the trunk, because it was complete, did not have the capacity to locate extra suitcases that a passenger could carry, the guide can request that the extra luggage be sent to the point that the passenger decides at his own expense.



HOTELS

Our hotels are carefully chosen and selected according to their location in the cities and also taking into account good communication with the urban center.

As indicated in each itinerary, hotels are preferably 4* category.

The rooms are doubles, two beds or a double bed and have a private bathroom / shower. In those cases in which a room is requested to be occupied by 3 people and as long as the request has been confirmed, the room will have an additional bed for the third person.

According to the hotel regulations, the time of entry into the rooms on the day of arrival is 2:00 p.m. and the time of departure is 12:00 p.m. If, due to flights, passengers arrive before these times and want to have their rooms, we recommend that an additional night be requested with the consequent supplement.



ADDITIONAL NIGHTS

If you wish to advance or extend your stay before or after a circuit, we give you the option of requesting additional nights up to a maximum of 2 nights before or after the scheduled start or end dates of the circuit.

In this catalog we indicate the best price for these additional nights in the cities most frequently required. If the city you requested is not in this relationship, do not hesitate to ask your Travel Agency for the information.

1. Transportation or medical repatriation in the event of illness or accident of the displaced Insured, to a properly equipped health center or to their country or place of habitual residence.
2. Medical assistance (hospitalization expenses, surgical interventions, medical fees, nursing expenses and pharmaceutical products) in the event of illness or accident of the Insured moved abroad (up to € 30,000 maximum).
3. Travel and accommodation of a person accompanying the Insured hospitalized in the event of illness or accident (resident in the country or place of habitual residence of the Insured at his or her choice). Travel to the place of hospitalization (round trip) and stay of the family member (up to € 600 / Maximum ten days).
4. Extension of the stay of the displaced Insured, in case of illness or accident and always by medical prescription (up to € 600 / maximum ten days).
5. Transportation or repatriation of the deceased Insured and displacement of an accompanying person (resident in the country or place of habitual residence of the Insured) who accompanies the body, to the place of burial, cremation or funeral ceremony in his country of habitual residence.
6. Compensation in the event of loss, theft or total or partial destruction of all checked luggage and personal effects, during transport by the transport company (up to € 300 maximum).

8. Compensation for death or permanent disability as a result of an accident in the means of transport (up to € 30,000).

AND DON'T FORGET TO:

- Check your personal documents, that your passport is valid and in order (recommended passport with a minimum validity of 6 months), that you have processed the visas required by each country, and before leaving home make sure you do not forget anything: documents of travel, passport, money, credit cards ... And before leaving, make a photocopy of your complete documentation to facilitate your recovery in case of loss (passport, cards, etc.).
- Put in your luggage what is really necessary depending on the duration of the trip and the countries to visit. Wear suitable clothing and comfortable shoes, because to get to know the cities well you have to walk. In summer preferably light cotton clothing, and in winter keep in mind that continental temperatures can be quite extreme. Attention the weight limitations on airplanes. During the coach trip, the maximum transport of one suitcase (max. 23 kg) is allowed, which will be located in the trunk of the coach, and one handbag per person.

Rome was first called The Eternal City by the Roman poet Tibullus in the 1st century BC, and the expression was also taken up by Ovid, Virgil, and Livy. It is also called "Caput Mundi" (Capital of the World). After the fall of the Empire in the west, which marked the beginning of the Middle Ages, Rome slowly fell under the political control of the Papacy, and in the 8th century it became the capital of the Papal States, which lasted until 1870. Overnight.

ITINERARY

Day 1 - (Friday) ROME

Arrival at the local airport and transfer to the Hotel. Free afternoon to tour the city on our own and do some shopping. Overnight.

Day 2 - (Saturday) ROME

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Today we will enjoy a sightseeing panoramic tour of the city with a local guide, driving through the most important places: Piazza Venezia, Via Veneto, the Roman Forums, the Colosseum, the Arch of Constantine, Castel Sant'Angelo, and others. We will continue with the visit of the Vatican Museums including the famous Sistine Chapel and the Basilica of St. Peter. Lunch is included. Afternoon free, we recommend an optional visit inside the Coliseum and the Forums. Overnight.

Day 3 - (Sunday) ROME

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Free day to continue visiting this fascinating city on your own. On Sundays at noon, the Pope traditionally prays the Angelus in St. Peter's Square and imparts the blessing Urbi et Orbi to the crowd: we recommend to attend it on your own, no tickets are required. Overnight.

Day 4 - (Monday) ROME - PISA - FLORENCE

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Departure to Pisa. Upon arrival we will enjoy a regular city sightseeing tour. Pisa is a very pleasant and quite city, close to the sea, that has preserved various evidences of her past greatness. We visit the famous Piazza dei Miracoli (Field of Miracles), and will admire its Duomo, the Leaning Tower and the Baptistery. We visit the Cathedral. In the afternoon we will continue to Florence known worldwide as the "Cradle of the Renaissance". Overnight.

Day 5 - (Tuesday) FLORENCE - CHIANTI REGION - FLORENCE

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Today we leave for an unforgettable excursion day in the CHIANTI region, famous throughout the world for its wines and its enchanting landscape. We will travel through the most amazing areas of Tuscany, renowned around the world for its delicious wine and for the incomparable beauty of its countryside, where woods, vineyards and olive groves alternate, studded with rural estates, mansions and castles of rare beauty. We will visit an imposing medieval Castle with its historic winery, its beautiful garden and the

Patio: here we will enjoy a tasting of selected fine wines accompanied by local products. In the afternoon we return to Florence accommodation. Overnight.

Day 6 - (Wednesday) FLORENCE - MONTERIGGIONI - SAN GIMIGNANO - SIENA

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Our journey will start with an excursion through the beautiful hills of the Chianti countryside, offering an impressive vineyard setting and olive groves. Along the way, from the wide panoramic windows of our coach, we will discover the medieval village of Monteriggioni, surrounded by its famous walls that have remained intact until today. Upon arrival in Siena, we enjoy a walking guided tour of the old town starting from the famous Basilica of San Domenico (visit inside), a jewel of Renaissance art built in the thirteenth century, and preserving an important relic of Santa Caterina da Siena. The guided tour will continue with a visit to the Museum and the oratory of a "Contrada" where we will discover the authentic atmosphere of the city. The "Contradas" (the neighborhoods into which the city is divided) are the real core of local social life, where the inhabitants of each district compete with each other to prepare the famous horse race known as the Palio. Each contrada is not simply a neighborhood: it can be compared to a small state with its own legacy of traditions, memories and feelings, in addition to its flag and anthem. After free lunch we head to San Gimignano, a small walled town located on a hill, which has remained intact throughout the centuries and is famous for its tall towers, frescoes and other valuable works of art. We will visit a small and fascinating museum housed in a medieval palace. At the end of our visit, we enjoy a tasting of the aromatic and delicious Siennese artisan pastries of medieval tradition (ricciarelli and panforte) together with the famous local wines, among which the Vernaccia di San Gimignano stands out. We return to Florence. Overnight.

Day 7 - (Thursday) SIENA - PIENZA - MONTEPULCIANO - ORVIETO - ROME

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. We will start our excursion to the Val D'Orcia, a World Heritage Site for the Unesco since 2004, where we will find two little gems of Italy, the cities of Pienza and Montepulciano. Pienza is considered the "touchstone of Renaissance urbanism". It is considered the Renaissance utopia incarnation of an ideal city, which, from an architectural point of view, is characterized by a rational organization of the open spaces

and perspectives of squares and palaces, for this reason, in 1996 the Unesco declared the historic center of the city as Humanity's Heritage. Here we will admire its architectural treasures, its beautiful Renaissance buildings and impressive churches. Another feature of this city is its old wine tradition, the Nobile of Montepulciano, one of the most famous Tuscan wines. We will enjoy a fantastic wine tasting in one of the most popular wineries in the region. We then continue to Orvieto, a small town of Etruscan origin, known for its beautiful 14th century cathedral considered one of the masterpieces of Italian Gothic architecture. After visit we continue on to Rome and our hotel. Overnight.

Day 8 - (Friday) ROMA

Breakfast. Free time until your transfer to the local airport, in time for your flight back. End of services.

We visit the famous Piazza dei Miracoli (Field of Miracles), and will admire its Duomo, the Leaning Tower and the Baptistery. We visit the Cathedral. In the afternoon we will continue to La Spezia. Overnight.

Day 5 - (Tuesday) LA SPEZIA – CINQUE TERRE – SIENA (225 kms)

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Departure on a full day excursion at famous "Cinque Terre". Five fascinating towns of vivid colors located on cliffs above the sea. Hundreds of hiking trails run through this unspoiled landscape, framed by nature and wonderful views. We will enjoy Castles, walls and other ancient buildings, as well as many small beaches, some of them isolated and unspoiled. In the afternoon we will continue towards Siena. Overnight.

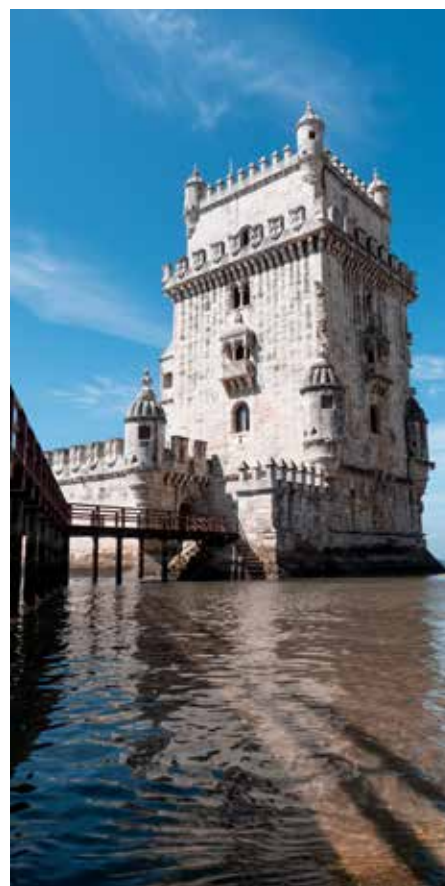

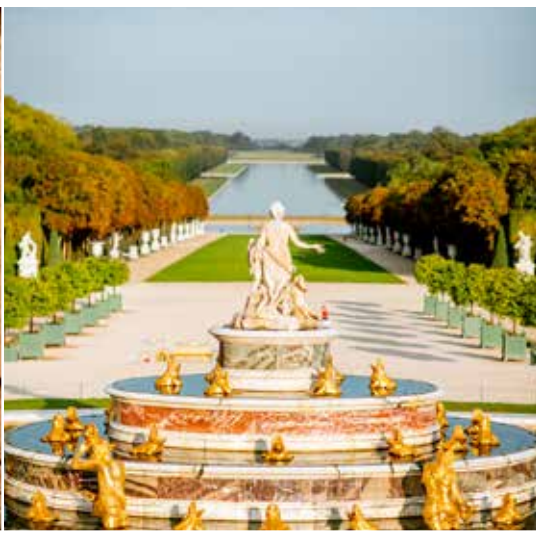

We will appreciate the Propylaea, temple of Athens Nike, Erechtheum and all its magnificent constructions. After Acropolis we will visit the Acropolis Museum, a building of a modern architecture, hosting the unique antiquities from the Acropolis. Enjoy the free afternoon to discover the center of Athens around Acropolis, strolling through Monastiraki, Plaka and Thissio, enjoying the pleasant sites of the ancient city.

Day 3 - EPIDAUROS - MYCENAE - OLYMPIA

In the morning we leave Athens to Corinth Canal. After a brief stop in the Canal which connects the Aegean Sea with the Ionian Sea, we continue to Epidauros. Here we enter into the culture of the 4th century BC and admire the Theatre of Epidauros, which is famous for having an exceptional

acoustics that allows almost perfect hearing of the unamplified voice stage for any of the 15,000 places in which each viewer can be seated. The city of Epidauros was one of the most important pilgrimage centers of antiquity for having the famous shrine of the God Asclepius doctor. The theater for his see is now the best preserved theater of antiquity. Depart for Nauplion, this picturesque town which was the first capital of Greece after the Turkish rule, in 1821. This beautiful town, nestled at the foot of the cliff were the Palamidi Fortresses on the top. After passing by the old town we continue and visit the Acropolis of Mycenae, the Homeric city of King Atreides, the city "rich in gold" of the ancient poets, where we will see the tomb of Agamemnon, the "Lionsgate" and Cyclopean walls among other interests of antiquity. Late in the afternoon, depart to the birthplace city of the Olympic games called Olympia, through Tripolis and Megapolis in the center of Peloponnese.

Day 4 - OLYMPIA

After breakfast we will visit the archaeological site of Olympia, the site of the Olympic games of the Classic Era, which were held every four years during antiquity, from the 8th century BC to the 4th century AD. We will see the temple of Olympian Zeus with the famous statue of Zeus, which was about 13 meters and was made out of gold and ivory, one of the seven wonders of the ancient world that the sculptor Phidias took about twelve years to build. We will go by the old stadium, that hosted the various sports of the Olympic games, and the archaeological museum. Leaving Olympia northward and through the plain of Iliad and Achaia, we arrive at the magnificent bridge which unites the Rio with Antirio and passes over the bay of Corinth. Continuing our path and passing through the picturesque towns of Itea and Nafpaktos we reach the "center of the ancient world" Delphi.

Day 5 - DELPHI

In the morning we will visit the archaeological site and museum of Delphi, where we see the Omphalos which was the "navel" center of the universe and whose

fame extended far beyond the borders of Greece, kept in the temple of the wrath Apollo. Inside the museum enjoy some masterpieces of ancient Greek sculpture as the famous athlete Aghias and the Brass Charioteer. The Oracle of Delphi acquired great influence in the world. The predictions of the priestess of Apollo called Pythia, influenced the decisions and had a great impact on the history of the cities of ancient times. Walk the Via Sacra which arrives at the temple of Apollo. After visiting and getting to know this legendary location, we will continue our journey to the town of Kalambaka, an inspiring and impressive destination.

Day 6 - METEORA

Kalambaka is at the foot of this astonishing complex of Meteora, an impressive backdrop of gigantic rocks that appear to be suspended in the air, formed over 60 million years ago. On top of these rocks, the monks who settled after the 12th century, despite being almost inaccessible, built 24 monasteries in the hermit ideal time of the 15th century. Today six of these are kept which enjoy excellent specimens of Byzantine art. Meteora is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Depart in the afternoon from Kalambaka passing through the plains of Thessaly, Lamia and Thermopylae, where the monument of King Leonidas of Sparta is, and Thiva. Arrival at our final destination Athens late afternoon.

Day 7 - ATHENS

Free day in Athens. Start the morning experiencing a typical Greek coffee and explore the ancient and modern city. Walk the streets of the traditional neighborhoods of Plaka, Monastiraki and Thissio, where modern buildings blend with the old. Experience the spectacular Greek cuisine that is the basis of the Mediterranean diet and follow with a typical Greek drink "ouzo" or a good Greek wine and discover the real nightlife that Athens offers. 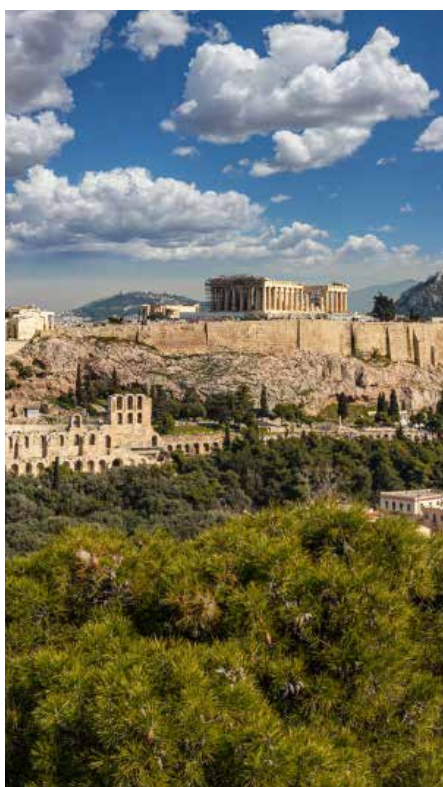

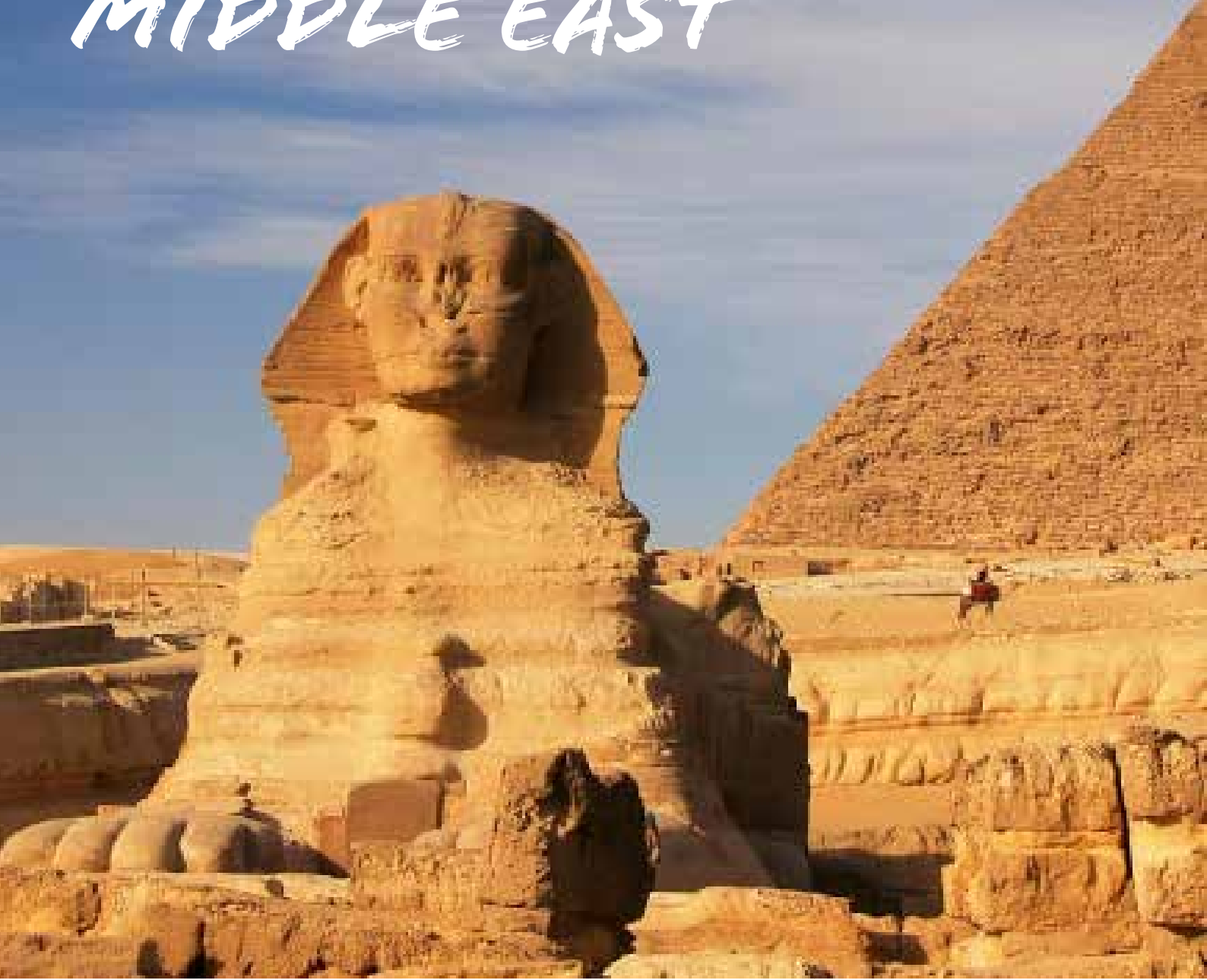

Day 1 (Thursday) - TEL AVIV

Arrive at Tiberias and check-in at your hotel. Overnight.

Day 3 (Saturday): SEA OF GALILEE

Breakfast at the hotel. Visit the sites on the north shore of the Sea of Galilee, the scene of many of the events in Jesus' life. Drive along the shore of the sea to Capernaum – known as "His Town", the center of Jesus ministry where he spent much time healing the sick and performing miracles. On to Tabgha, the site of Christ's miracle of feeding the 5,000, visiting the Church of Multiplication, where the mosaic floor depicts a basket with loaves and two fishes, and the Church of the Primacy of St Peter, commemorating Jesus' reinstatement of Peter as chief among the Apostles. Continue to the Mount of Beatitudes overlooking the sea, where Jesus preached the "Sermon on the Mount" and it is believed that he picked his 12 apostles. Ascend to the Golan Heights to view the panoramic view of the peaks of Mt. Hermon and the rugged Golan plateau. Visit Banias (Caesarea Philippi), one of the sources of the River Jordan, where Jesus took his disciples,

revealing his purpose and His Church before his last trip to Jerusalem and where Simon identified Jesus as the messiah. Drive to the southern part of the Sea of Galilee to visit the Yardenit Baptismal Site. Return to Tiberias for another night in town. Overnight.

Day 4 (Sunday): NAZARETH - JORDAN VALLEY - BEIT ALPHA - JERUSALEM

Breakfast at the hotel. Sail on a boat on the Sea of Galilee to experience the tranquility and the scenery that slightly changed during the past 2000 years (subject to conditions and fee). Travel through the Galilee to Nazareth, where Jesus spent his childhood, and the Church of Annunciation, built on the site where archaeologists believe the Archangel Gabriel appeared to the Virgin Mary. You will also see Mary's Well and Joseph's Church. Day 5 (Monday): MASADA & DEAD SEA

Breakfast at the hotel. Travel to Masada passing through the remarkable scenery of the Dead Sea. Masada is situated on an isolated cliff in the Judean Desert and was declared as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2001. Ascend by cable car to the fortress, which was the last stronghold of the Jewish Zealots in their war against the Romans. 1. LEGAL REGULATION AND ACCEPTANCE OF THE CONDITIONS

These General Terms and Conditions are subject to the regulation of the Book IV of the Royal Legislative Decree 1/2007, dated November 16, 2007, and other rules in force. Once signed by the contracting parties, these General Conditions will be incorporated into all tourist package contracts concerning the tours and offers contained in this brochure, which oblige the parties to the particular conditions agreed in it as well as the provision of the services indicated in the travel documentation provided simultaneously with the signing of the contract. The contracting parties expressly submit to the jurisdiction and competence of the Spanish Courts with authority in the place where the obligation is performed, waiving their own jurisdiction.

2. ORGANIZATION

The tours mentioned in this brochure has been arranged by EUROPEANDO S.L. CIF B-87173696. CICMA license title n° 3207.

3. PRICE

3.1. The price of the combined tours include

- Transportation according to itinerary.
- The hotels mentioned in the brochure are merely for information and the accommodation and / or meals (if included) in the hotels or in other similar establishments can be changed without notice with structures of equal value and category- The included breakfasts will be "continental type" unless otherwise indicated.
- Hotel taxes and indirect taxes (v.a.t.; i.g.i.c.) when they are applicable.
- Technical assistance during the tours, when this service is specifically included.
- All other services and supplements specifically mentioned in the itineraries and all that is further specified in the contract.

The expected waiting time at the airport for arrival transfers is set at a maximum of 90 minutes from the flight's arrival. Rates and descriptions in this brochure are valid except for topographical errors.

3.2. Price adjustments

The price of each package tour has been calculated on the basis of the current exchange rates, transport charges, fuel costs and taxes applicable on the date of issue of this brochure or any subsequent publications, if any, made public in printed form.

Any change in the price of the items indicated above may result in the revision of the final price of the tours, both increasing and decreasing, strictly in the price changes to which they refer.

3.3. Exclusions

- Package Tour's rates do not include Visas, airport taxes, and / or entry and exit taxes, vaccination certificates, "extras" such as coffees, wines, spirits, mineral waters, special diets, washing and ironing of clothes, optional hotel services, and in general any services or benefits not expressly mentioned in the brochure, schedule or documentation of the journey.

4. PAYMENT METHOD. REGISTRATIONS AND REFUNDS

The Agency will require at the moment of registration a deposit of 40% of the total amount of the contracted tour price and will issue a receipt: nothing will be booked until the above deposit is paid. The remaining 60% must be paid at least seven days before the departure date, otherwise the tour will be considered as canceled, and the conditions set out in the cancellation terms shall apply. All refunds made for any reason, will always be formalized through the Travel Agency where the registration was made, no refund is made for services not used voluntarily by the customer.

5. CANCELLATIONS

At any time the user or customer may withdraw from the services requested or contracted, being entitled to a refund of the amounts paid both the total price or the deposit paid. In any case the customer shall compensate the Agency for the following:

- Operational costs plus cancellation costs, if any.
- A penalty fee consisting of 15% of the total trip, if the withdrawal occurs more than ten and less than fifteen days before the departure; 50% from day 3 to 10 before departure and 75% within the 48 hours before departure.

In case of no-show at the departure, the penalty fee will be 100% of the total amount of the trip, paying, where appropriate, the outstanding amounts, unless otherwise agreed by the parties. In the event that any of the contracted and canceled services were subject to special economic conditions of contracting, such as airfare, ships, special rates, etc., the cancellation costs for withdrawal will be established in accordance with the conditions agreed by both parties. A minimum of fifteen passengers is required to carry out the tours. In case this quota has not been obtained, the trip will be automatically canceled, which will be notified in writing to the consumer, with a minimum of twenty days before the scheduled departure date, and in this case they will not be entitled to any compensation. The circuit may leave without an accompanying guide, with an expert driver who knows the routes.

6. ALTERATIONS

The Agency undertakes to provide its customers with the totality of the services agreed and contained in the package offered which originated the contract, with the stipulated conditions and characteristics. In the event that before departure the organizer is forced to significantly modify any essential item of the contract, it must immediately inform the consumer. In this case and unless the parties agree otherwise, the customer may choose between terminating the contract without any penalty, or accepting the modification of the contract in which the variations introduced and their impact on the price are specified. The customer must communicate the decision adopted to the retailer or, when appropriate, to the organizer, within three days after being notified. In the event that the consumer does not notify his decision in the indicated terms, it will be understood that he opts for the termination of the contract without any penalty.

In the event of contractual liability of the Agency provided for in this paragraph, the corresponding compensation shall be those regulated in Article 159,1 of Book IV of RD 1/2007 of 16/11/2007.

In the event of withdrawal or cancellation by the Agency, the Organizer and the Retailer will be responsible for refunding the customer the compensation provided in Book IV of RD 1/2007 of 11/16/2007, in the terms and conditions fixed therein as follows:

- 5% of the total package price, if the withdrawal occurs between two months and fifteen days

prior the tour departure date;

- 10%, if it occurs between the previous fifteen and three days prior the tour departure date;
- 25%, if it occurs in the previous 48 hours prior the tour departure date.

In the event that, after the departure of the trip, the Organizer does not supply or also verify that it cannot supply an important part of the services provided for in the contract, it will adopt the appropriate solutions for the continuation of the organized tour without any additional price for the customer, and, if necessary, will pay the latter the amount of the difference between the benefits expected and those provided. If the customer continues the trip with the solutions given by the Organizer, it will be considered that they tacitly accept said proposals. If the solutions adopted by the Organizer are unfeasible, or the consumer does not accept them for reasonable reasons, the Organizer must provide the Customer, without any supplement, a means of transport equivalent to that used on the trip to return to the place of departure or to any other place that both have agreed, without prejudice to the compensation that may be appropriate.

7. RESPONSIBILITY

The Organizers and Retailers of package tours will respond to the Customer, depending on the obligations that correspond to them by their respective area of management of the package trip, for the correct fulfillment of the obligations deriving from the contract, regardless of whether they are to be carried out by themselves or by other service providers, and without prejudice to the right of Organisers and Retailers to take action against such service providers.

The organizers and retailers of package tours will also be liable for the damages suffered by the customer as a result of the failure or incorrect execution of the contract. Said responsibility will cease when any of the following circumstances occurs:

- That the defects observed in the execution of the contract are caused by the Customer;
- That said defects are attributable to a third party unrelated to the provision of the services provided for in the contract and are unpredictable or insurmountable;
- That the aforementioned defects are due to reasons of force majeure, meaning that such those circumstances beyond the control of the person invoking them, abnormal and unforeseeable, the consequences of which could not have been avoided despite having acted with due diligence;
- That the defects are due to an event that the Retailer or, where appropriate, the Organizer, despite having put all the necessary diligence, could not foresee or overcome.

When the customer verifies the non-execution or defective execution of the contracted services "in situ", he must immediately notify the provider of the same, and within 48 business hours to the Organizing Agency, in order to be able to solve it immediately, since, outside of that period, it would be almost impossible for it to verify the veracity of the allegations. In the event that the consumer considers that the solutions arbitrated by the Organizing Agency have not been satisfactory, he may submit a claim within a period of one month from the date of return from the trip with the aforementioned Organizing Agency, which will be presented through of the Retail Agency that sold the trip, and in which it will be credited to have made manifest the presumed breach in the 48 hours following its occurrence. However, the filing of any claim derived from the package travel contract does not exempt the payment of the trip in any case. In the case of damage other than personal injury, compensation may never exceed the total price of the trip initially contracted. In no case is the Agency responsible for accommodation, maintenance, transportation and other expenses that arise as a result of delays in departures or returns of means of transport due to weather, technical, strikes or other force majeure. When the trip is made in coaches of its own or rented by the Organizing Agency, in the event of an accident, regardless of the country where it occurs, the consumer expressly submits to the legislation on road accidents of the nation in which it is registered the vehicle. The main contractor, declares to have the powers to contract on behalf of the remaining beneficiaries of the trip integrated in the same reservation locator, and also declares to know and accept everything outlined in the clauses of this contract, as well as expressly declares to have knowledge of the risks inherent to the trip that is the object of this contract.

8. PASSPORTS, VISAS AND DOCUMENTATION

The client receives a general information about the conditions that apply to them in terms of passports and visas, and the health formalities necessary for the trip and stay. All users, without exception (children included), must carry their corresponding personal and family documentation, be it their passport or ID, according to the laws of the country or countries they are visiting. It will be their duty obtaining visas, passports, vaccination certificates, etc., when required. If the granting of visas is rejected by any Authority, for particular reasons of the user, or their entry into a country is denied due to lack of the necessary requirements or due to defects in the required documentation, or by not being the carrier of the same, the Organizing Agency will not be responsible in any case, being on behalf of the consumer all the expenses that for these reasons originate.

9. BAGGAGE

The baggage and other personal effects of the customer are not the subject of the tourist package contract, it being understood that in terms of land transport and to all effects, the user keeps them with him regardless of where they are placed in the part of the vehicle in which is traveling and transported at the user's own risk, without the Organizing Agency being held responsible for loss, theft or damage that it may suffer during the trip for any reason, including the management of hotel / airport transfers or vice versa, when they exist. Users are recommended to be present in all baggage loading and unloading operations. Due to the limited capacity of the buses, a maximum of one suitcase (max. 20 kg) and one bag per person will be allowed.

10. INSURANCE

These Package tours are covered by accident insurance. Consumers receive information on the coverage, as well as the possibility of contracting an insurance that covers the cancellation costs by the consumer, or an assistance contract that covers the costs of transfer to the place the ground services begin, in case of accident, illness or death.

11. VALIDITY

However, changes in that information shall be valid, both in the characteristics of the services covered and in the prices thereof, if communicated to the Customer before the conclusion of the contract or where modifications have been agreed between the parties.

Note: Sections no.3.3, 3.4.2, 3.4.3, 3.4.4, 7, 8, 10, and 12 of these general conditions will be available to customers in accordance with the provisions of Book IV of the Royal Decree of 1/2007 of 11/16/2007.
